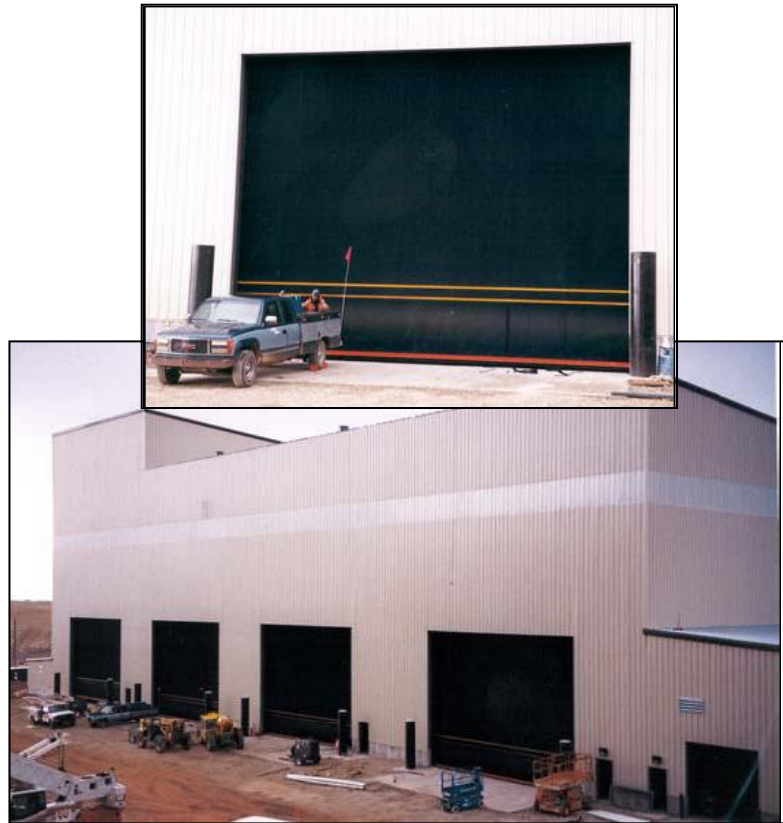


## Cripple Creek and Victor Joint Venture Truck Shop Chooses UltraTough &I for Rocky M Mountain Facility



Albany Door Systems successfully met the challenge of providing doors for the new Cripple Creek and Victor Joint Venture truck shop situated on top of a mountain, 10,000 ft. above sea level.

This surface mine shop is designed to maintain a fleet of 290-ton haul trucks and various other mining equipment. Cripple Creek has three service bays and one wash bay keeping these expensive haulers running.

These **UltraTough M&I** doors will be subjected to the brutal conditions of the Rocky Mountains including high winds, snowstorms and long periods of below freezing temperature. The doors feature the extremely durable, impact resistant, black SBR rubber door curtain, proven in this application and backed by a lifetime warranty.

The patented windlok feature tightly seals the perimeter of the door opening keeping air infiltration to a minimum. Controlling the service bay and truck wash internal temperatures will decrease energy costs and improve working conditions.

**UltraTough M&I** doors were originally developed for the mining industry. All doors are custom built, withstand wind speeds of 88mph, and are available up to 50 feet wide.
